Steve Weisbart is Chair of the Named Fiduciaries of the Pension Plan for Insurance Organizations (PPIO). He was elected to be a Named Fiduciary in 2012. He considers this position to be the culmination of a 50-year career in the insurance industry. With a Ph.D. in Applied Economics from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania, Steve was recruited to the faculty of Georgia State University, where he rose to be a tenured Associate Professor of Insurance. He left to take a Vice Presidency at Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association (TIAA), then switched to the Insurance Information Institute (Triple-I), where he became Chief Economist. He retired from the Triple-I in November 2020 but remains a Non-Resident Scholar there.

While at Georgia State he wrote or co-wrote four books and several research papers and was an Assistant Editor of the CLU Journal. At the Triple-I he made dozens of presentations to industry groups each year and was quoted in numerous newspapers and magazines and appeared on cable news programs. He has been a career-long member of the American Risk and Insurance Association (ARIA) and is a member of the American Economic Association.
