Dear Association Member:

In September, the Board of Directors of the Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association approved an other lines insurance assessment. The assessment is needed to pay covered claims from existing other lines insurer liquidations and related claims handling expenses.

The aggregate total of the assessment is \$75 million for all member companies writing other lines insurance in 2021.

The individual assessment to each member company is calculated according to its portion of the total 2021 net direct written premiums in Texas (minus dividends credited) for the other lines line of business. Negative premiums were assigned as \$0 for the assessment. Impaired insurers are not included in the calculation.
